Through its main campus in Reading and locations in Philadelphia and Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, the university serves 3,000 students of diverse backgrounds from around the country and the world.

Alvernia offers a unique blend of rigorous liberal arts core education for development of the mind, strong technical training in many high demand majors, experiential learning through study abroad, research and internship experiences, and engagement with the community through our Franciscan-based community service model. Campus Commons



Alvernia's Recreation, Wellness & Health Sciences Complex

The FLYNN PLEX provides inter-professional teaching spaces for growing health sciences programs, integrating experiential training for students in programs such as nursing, occupational therapy, physical therapy, athletic training, social work and counseling. This concept enhances learning and provides a distinctive competitive advantage over both peer schools and larger universities.

Contemporary, flexible general-use classrooms of various sizes and styles serve multiple academic programs, offering state-of-the-art technology and instructional environments that encourage group work and collaboration. A large, tiered lecture hall accommodates expansion of popular academic programs and serves local community organizations as a vital resource for meeting space. It includes a field house designed to provide indoor recreation space for all students and the campus community.

The expansion is the largest, most ambitious in university history, adding more than 100,000 square feet of academic and recreation space and 15 acres to Alvernia's campus.

Alvernia is located in a quiet residential neighborhood just minutes from downtown Reading, Pennsylvania, in the heart of historic Berks County. Reading offers a mix of cultural entertainment destinations such as the GoggleWorks Center for the Arts, the Reading Public Museum, outlet shopping, minor-league sports (Fightin Phils, Royals, United and Express) and concerts at the Santander Arena.


